

Bylaw 2016-01
Creating Regional Organizing Committees

WHEREAS, significant numbers of students in Delta Phi Epsilon and fraternity and sorority alumni reside outside of the District of Columbia; and

WHEREAS, committees catering to local interests would help attract members outside of the District of Columbia and free the Executive Council and Steering Group to focus on Society activities at the national level:

§1 Acting under Section 8.3 of the Society Constitution, the Steering Group of the Society creates the following committees to carry on the work of the Society:

- (1). The District of Columbia Coordinating Committee
- (2). The New York Coordinating Committee
- (3). The San Francisco Bay Coordinating Committee

§1.2 These committees shall assist the Executive Council and its Membership Committee with member recruiting and retention in their local areas, and shall generally assist with development of local events and other programming. The Executive Council may direct the Committees to carry out specific tasks as needed.

§2 Each committee will become active when ten student or annual members join the committee.

§2.1 Each committee will be empowered to elect a Chair and set any necessary internal procedures, so long as they are not inconsistent with the provisions of the Constitution.
